Dr. Cole is the Medical Director of the Columbus Regional Breast Care Center on Hamilton Road. She is a board certified radiologist with specialized training and experience in breast imaging interpretations and clinical interventions. She is the area's only radiologist fellowship-trained in mammography. She completed her medical school at Meharry Medical College in Nashville TN and her Internship at Grady Memorial Hospital in Atlanta, Ga. She completed her radiology residency at Tufts University in Boston Ma and completed a Breast Imaging fellowship at Harvard University in Cambridge, MA. She is specialty trained in 3D digital breast tom synthesis, ultrasound and MRI-guided breast biopsies, stereotactic core biopsies, pre-operative needle localizations and fine needle aspirations.
